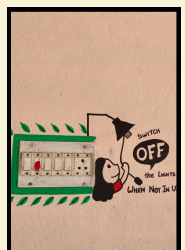

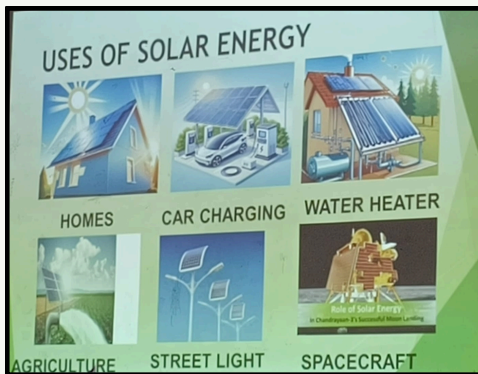


United for Energy Conservation

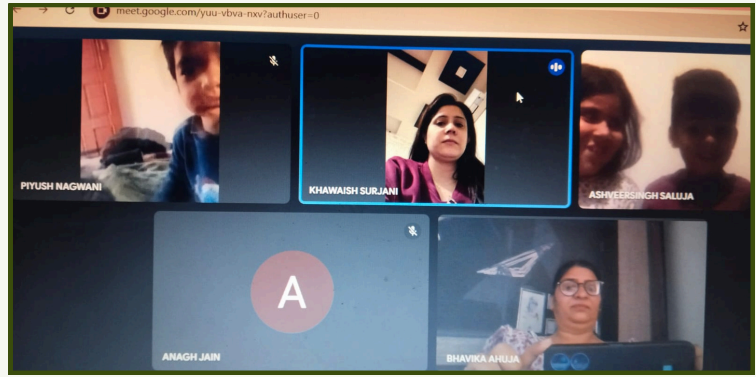


Students have made the practice of pouring the remaining water of their water bottles into plants, ensuring that not a single drop is wasted.

Students of MYP 1A advocated for energy conservation in the form of a song performance.

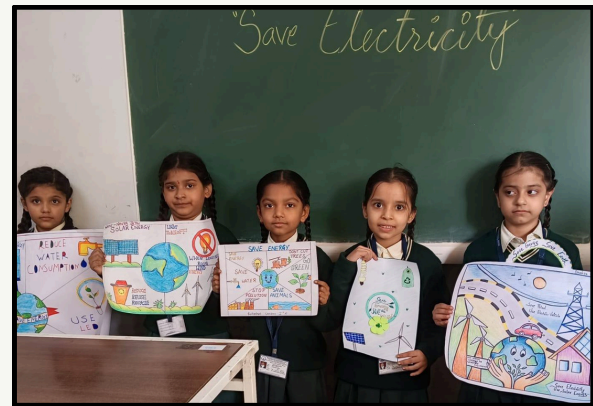
