# BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE CHAPTER:

## LEARNING OBJECTIVES:

This lesson will enable the students to - **SP1-** Understand that editing involves making changes in existing text. (U)

SP2- Learn the process of selecting text using both the mouse and keyboard. (U)

SP3- Demonstrate different methods of deleting text according to user requirements. (U)

SP4- Show how text can be inserted by positioning the cursor and typing. (U)

**SP5-** Introduce the Undo feature to cancel commands and the Redo feature to reverse the actions of Undo. (K)

**SP6-** Familiarize students with the icons and shortcut keys for Undo and Redo actions. Introduce cutting as moving text and copying as duplicating text. (K)

**SP7-** Demonstrate the steps for cut-paste and copy-paste operations in a Word document. Introduce the Spelling and Grammar Check feature of MS Word. (U)

**SP8-** Show how spelling and grammar mistakes are represented with different colored wavy lines. (K)

**SP9-** Demonstrate the method of using the Spelling and Grammar Check feature in MS Word. Top of Form. (U)

#### **BEHAVIOURAL OBJECTIVES:**

This lesson will enable the students to

**B1-** edit text by selecting, deleting, inserting, and formatting it using various techniques, as well as utilize features such as Undo, Redo, Cut-Paste, Copy-Paste, and Spelling and Grammar Check in MS Word. (A)
