Forms of Power Sharing Horizontal power sharing • Power is shared among different organs of government, such as the legislature, executive and judiciary. This is called the horizontal distribution of power because it allows different organs of government placed at the same level to exercise different powers. • Such a separation ensures that none of the organs can exercise unlimited power. Each organ checks the others. This results in a balance of power among various institutions.
