Lesson Plan 3

Class - VII Subject – English

Literature: Chapter 1 Darwin Diaries

Brief Description: This is a story of five year long historic expedition(1832-1836) of a British naturalist Charles Darwin, based on which Darwin wrote his famous book, on the Origin of Species. This account is narrated by ten year old James Kincaid through a series of entries in his diary. In this extract, James, recounts their voyage to the Galapagos Islands between 15th September and 20th October, 1835.
