

LESSON PLAN-6

CLASS -2 SUBJECT- ENGLISH

TOPIC- Describing Words, Verbs.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION

This lesson plan will give awareness to students about describing words and verbs with help of the lesson “ Friends Next Door”. They will be able to describe nouns and come to know that action words are also called verbs.

OBJECTIVES:-

I- Specific Objectives:-

The students will be able to

S1.1- Define Verbs. (knowledge)

S1.2- List the describing words and verbs from exercise.
(Knowledge)

S1.3- Develop the understanding that colours, shapes, sizes , numbers and feelings are describing words. (Understanding)

S1.4- Describe a day, person, touch and texture.
(Understanding)

PROCESS/ACTIVITIES:

S1. 1- Introductory discussion .Describe your favourite toy or object.

S1.2, S1.3- Playing some sensory games and describe texture. Eg: soft, smooth, fluffy, rough, hard etc.

S1.4, B1.1,B1.2- Word search

Students will find different descriptive words in a small story and use them to frame their own story.

S1.3,S1.4 Verb charades

Students will play game and come to know that verbs are action words.

B1.1, B1.5, B1.6 Missing word worksheet

Students will fill in blanks by the usage of polite words.
