TOPIC – (Grammar) L 6 Singular and Plural

BRIEF DESCRIPTION

The lesson aims to help young learners singular and plural nouns.

OBJECTIVES:

- ACT 1- Warm-Up Ask some questions to check their previous knowledge about singular or plural noun
- ACT 2 - Introduction and explanation of the rules for forming plurals. (board and videos)
- ACT 3 Ask students to find and write down the singular or plural nouns in a story from their literature book. Then write down their respective plural and singular forms.
- ACT 4 Teacher writes a few nouns on the board. Students will work with their partner to give the plural form of the nouns shown by teacher.
- ACT 5 Students will be able to make basic sentence using singular and plural nouns.
- ACT 6 Workbook exercises.
